NURSE KITCHEN

Savabeel's Gr.2 Moonee Valley Fillies Classic winning and Gr.1 placed daughter Nurse Kitchen provided her breeder/owners Sarah and Peter Moody with a \$1.7million thrill at Magic Millions' National Broodmare Sale this week.

Nurse Kitchen was, in fact, one of two Savabeels to sell for over a million, with Denise Howell's dual Gr.1 winner Soriano also exceeding this limit at \$1.15m.

Having nearly lost Nurse Kitchen's dam, Flying Monty, when she suffered a form of sciatic nerve paralysis following a difficult foaling, the result was especially sweet for the Moodys.

"Certainly as a breeder Nurse Kitchen selling for \$1.7 million to the China Horse Club was a massive thrill," said Peter Moody.

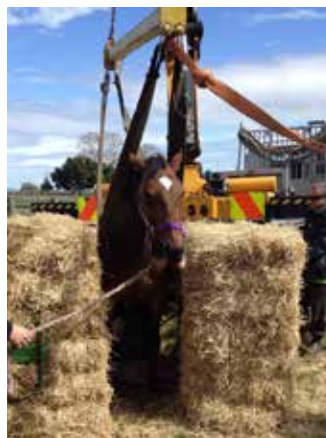
"We owe a massive thanks to Mark and his team at Waikato Stud, who worked tirelessly to save Flying Monty and who subsequently enabled her to be strong and healthy enough to conceive Nurse Kitchen later that season."

Flying Monty has a weanling filly by Savabeel and is currently in foal to Ocean Park.

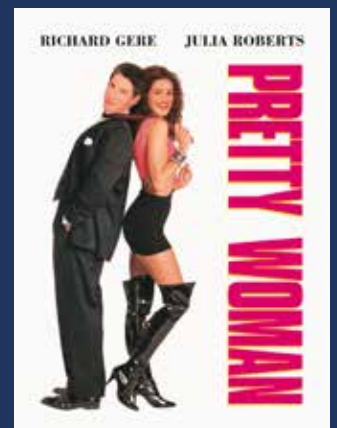

SAVABEEL

KAISER FRANZ

Savabeel realised his 19th individual stakes winner for the season last Saturday, when his 6YO son Kaiser Franz registered a half-length win in the Gr.3 Premier's Cup (2200m) at Eagle Farm.

Kaiser Franz is trained by Robert Heathcote, who had an inkling the horse would turn his last start form around in the race.

"I copped a bit of flak from the owners for running him, and I noticed he was big odds before the jump, but I had a sneaky feeling that he'd love this track," Heathcote said.

"He's run second last, gone at the 600 (metres) the last start, but I liked his run the start before that on this track.

"Today was his big test, and maybe it's pie in the sky to run him in the Brisbane Cup but the extra 200 metres next time will suit him."

The now seven-time winner was originally purchased by Paul Willetts, who secured the gelding from Trelawney Stud's 2012 Premier draft for \$65,000.

Bred by Denise Howell, Kaiser Franz is out of Call Me Lily - the noted dam of Savabeel's dual Gr.1 winner, Soriano, who sold at the Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale this week for \$1.15mil.

AMPIN - Broodmare

Lovely, strong and well-balanced five-year-old Pins mare in foal to Savabeel. Unraced due to injury. Ampin's sire Pins is a remarkable broodmare sire with a 5.1% stakes winners to runners ratio including Group 1 standouts Stratum Star and Brambles.

Ampin carries a positive test to the New Zealand's award-sweeping Group 1 sire Savabeel, with an early foaling due date of 15/9/2017.

No vices other than she is needle shy. She has a great breeding history and has had a positive pregnancy scan done in the last seven days.



MEGAN O'REILLY - Broodmare

Attractive and scopey three-year-old filly in foal to the Gr.1 winning Fastnet Rock sire, Rock 'n' Pop. Excellent breeding history. Due to foal 19/08/2017.

Her sire O'Reilly has achieved terrific success as a damsire. With 7.3% stakes winners to runners here, O'Reilly has the highest stakes winners to runners percentage in Australasia and is strongly recommended by 11 individual Group 1 winners

This mare has no known vices. Note: Being a maiden mare, she was sedated when in the crush. She has had a positive pregnancy scan done in the last 7 days.



TWILIGHT GRANITA - Broodmare

Stakes winning seven-year-old Iffraaj mare in foal to 5x Group 1 winning stallion Ocean Park. This mare won at Listed level and also ran 2nd in the Group 1 NZ Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes. Standing at approx. 16.2hh, she is a stand-out mare with good bone and correct conformation. She is due to foal 8/11/2017. She has had a positive pregnancy scan done in the last 7 days.



HARD GRAFT - RACING/BREEDING PROSPECT

Three-year-old filly by Champion sire Savabeel out of the winning Dynaformer mare Former Glory. Lovely type of filly with good conformation. Selling as a racing or breeding prospect.



SAVABEEL - AMPIN COLT - Weanling

Weanling colt by Champion sire Savabeel out of the Pins mare Ampin.

This bay colt was born 30/08/2016 and is very strong and well-balanced. He has correct conformation, is an attractive type and has a great temperament.

OCEAN PARK - TWILIGHT GRANITA COLT - Weanling

Weanling colt by 5x Gr.1 winning stallion Ocean Park out of the stakes-winning Iffraaj mare Twilight Granita.

This chestnut colt was born 12/11/2016 and is an attractive weanling with correct conformation and a great temperament.

CORNER

Sometimes it's hard to comment weekly and make a worthwhile point, or any sense. Well, the Gold Coast Broodmare Sale is worth comment even if it doesn't make sense.

Firstly let me congratulate Gerry Harvey – a marketer of no equal. A lot will not remember when Gerry decided to elevate his June sale to a National Sale. To attract the best mares on offer, his carrot was no commission for any sale over 100k. Existing sale companies suffered a case of severe tightening of their sphincter muscles, muttering many views of the sense in running a sale under such conditions.

Well, it quite clearly has worked. At the time of writing this corner, two days of selling had been completed grossing \$78m – a record for any Magic Millions sale. You can rest assured sales over 100k now attract commission, with the catalogue and company attracting buyers from all over the world. Well done!

I am not sure the distance to and from the Hunter Valley, but the bulk of these mares will have travelled probably 1500 kilometres during the fortnight at great cost. Imagine the savings if these horses were all assembled and sold at Scone. What an event it would be. (Gerry is bound to have shares in the float companies).

So who are these investors? The spread is great: USA, Ireland, NZ, England, Australia, and our new enthusiasts China. The results illustrate the importance of their involvement. I will only name a couple: the China Horse Club, The Sun Group, Aquis, Yu Long...these are the ones I have met. It would seem to me they are determined to make their mark both here and possibly China in the future.

I think it's great! Its new money and you can never have enough new money. There is, as always new domestic players in Australia. You know the guy who has just sold his business for squillions and is anxious to apply his successful business practice to bring those long-term breeders into the real world. We are grateful for the opportunity to share their expertise and, more importantly, their money.

The beauty of our game is you can breed or burn money. This sale has been one for the girls. Sarah Moody is much loved by the family; the \$1.7m for Nurse Kitchen with more of the family to come will prevent any further discussions on how many show jumpers are entitled to space on the farm. Denise Howell's \$1.150 for Soriano is just rewarded for the time she spends with Rogie – in fact, it might not be enough! Make sure you hang on to the purse strings Denise, but good luck to you. And to cap it off, both of these horses were by our one and only Savabeel, who has sold amazingly.

I read where there are 37 new stallions looking for mares in Australia this season. My understanding is around 16 thousand mares are mated. This means the new horses need 25 percent of available mares, so someone is going to miss out. For those newcomers to the industry, remember if 10 per cent succeed, that will be 3. Be careful where you mate those expensive mares. Make sure your ego doesn't get ahead of your IQ, it's happened before. I could name a few, but my space in the corner is limited.

Much excitement this week following the level of investments being made to secure Savabeel's progeny at the Magic Million National Broodmare Sale on the Gold Coast.

As you can see in the table below, Savabeel sold two horses for over \$1 million, with his 19th individual stakes winner for the season Kaiser Franz providing an ideal lead-up last weekend for his dual Gr.1 winning sister Soriano, who sold to Yu Long Investments for \$1.150million. Congratulations to her breeder/owner Denise Howell on this terrific result!

Perhaps the most personally rewarding sale, however, had to be the China Horse Club's \$1.7million purchase of Sarah and Peter Moody's Gr.2 winning and Gr.1 performed filly, Nurse Kitchen. She is a pretty special horse for Waikato Stud, with a lot of effort going into just keeping her dam alive at one point. To see her go on to reward Peter and Sarah with what she has on the racetrack and now in the sale ring is extremely rewarding to say the least.
