



LUCIA VALENTINA

Kris Lees is happy for **Savabeel's Queen Elizabeth Stakes** winner **Lucia Valentina** to fly under the radar as he prepares the multiple **Group One** winner for Saturday's **Cox Plate**.

The trainer is convinced the winner of Sydney's richest race is going just as well heading into Saturday's \$3 million feature at Moonee Valley. Lucia Valentina is at \$21 for the Cox Plate (2040m) in which defending champion Winx is at \$1.85 and in-form Hartnell is the only other horse under double figures at \$3.20.

Lees is aware of the task ahead against two in-form horses and a host of other topliners but also believes **Lucia Valentina** is somewhat forgotten in Cox Plate discussions.

"A little bit. Which is fine," Lees said.

"I think in other years she'd be a lot tighter in the market. But I think it's just a reflection on how these other two are going. And it's going to be a wonderful race."

"We feel we've got her here in a similar vein. It's probably a stronger race than the Queen Elizabeth, but she's getting here in really good order and I'm looking forward to Saturday."

Lucia Valentina got her first look around Moonee Valley last Thursday when she worked in company with Happy Trails.

Lees is content with barrier nine in the field of 10 as **Lucia Valentina** is a get-back runner armed with a powerful finishing sprint.





Sunshine, the great elixir of life. Well for some, any benefit I may have benefited from was diluted by Air New Zealand's breakdown of their ticketing programme resulting in a 4hour stand in 31degrees at Nandi Airport. Funny thing life, what will I remember most about Fiji is the last 4 hours.

But the sunshine is great... tracks will improve, form will change, mares will bloom with a dramatic improvement in conception rates.

As long as I have been in this game Labour weekend has always been the turning point. This is no old wives tale; our local haylage contractor tells us the lift in protein levels is dramatic with a bit of sun on our backs. The effect on all forms of agriculture is obvious.

It must have been very difficult for those training horses; we pre-train our fillies at home our track tested the patience of Dale and Katie. However, they presented our Ready to Run horses at the jump outs in pristine condition, well done.

I will leave the Racing Administrators alone this week, not enough sun on my back yet to eliminate my pessimism, however, interesting to read of the proposed merging of TabCorp and Tattersalls, perhaps they can see the benefits of rationalising, hopefully with the racing industry sharing the savings. Not sure how this leaves NZ with their relationship with TabCorp. Interesting challenges. Hope somebody's up to it.

PEDIGREE POINTERS

WITH GARETH DOWNEY

One of the biggest talking points to come out of the Randwick meeting last weekend was the super performance posted by **Spieth** in taking out the **Listed Lightning Handicap**. After missing the start, it looked like the wave of money for him may have been all washed up – but, in the style of top class performers, he overcame that adversity and posted some outstanding sectionals while weaving a path through the field and exploding to the **1st** stakes victory of his career. This was the **5th** win in his **8** start career, and he was first up for a new preparation over **1100m**. Wherever trainer Bryce Heys chooses to go with him over the Melbourne Spring Carnival, it will be exciting to watch the progression of this imposing galloper.

Spieth is another example of the affinity that has become apparent between his sire, Thorn Park, and Mill Reef. When these two sires have been combined on opposite sides of a pedigree to date, the results are running at 10.7% SW/Rnrs. Apart from Spieth, the other performers carrying this affinity have included Suavito, Debt Collector, Centennial Park, Soubrettes, Bonnie Mac etc.

As Ocean Park is by Thorn Park out of the Zabeel mare Sayyida, it is also very encouraging to see how well Zabeel and Mill Reef have combined together. When Zabeel and Mill Reef have been combined anywhere on opposite sides of a pedigree, the results are a very good 6.1% SW/

Rnrs and a remarkable ratio of a Gr.1 winner for every 50.3 runners. These are very good figures indeed over a sample size of 1106 runners, given all the various quality of carriers of these sire lines in that sample set – so this also suggests a very strong affinity between Zabeel and Mill Reef. The Gr.1 winners carrying this pattern include It's A Dundeel, Pierro, Silent Achiever, Hill Of Grace, Gust Of Wind, Kawi, Nashville, Fenway, Zabeelionaire, Art Success, Julinsky Prince, Laverock, Xtravagant, Sacred Elixir, Suntagonal, Costume, Gondokoro, Diademe, Provocative, O'Marilyn, Savaria and Irish Fling.

So, if you have a mare carrying Mill Reef, sending her to Ocean Park provides you with an excellent chance to tap into these proven affinities with both Thorn Park and Zabeel.
