Super sire **Savabeel** has three terrific **Gr.1** chances heading into Day Two of **The Championships** at Royal Randwick tomorrow.

LUCIA VALENTINA Aim- To take out the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth Stakes (2000m)

Best wins- Gr.1 ATC Vinery Stud Stakes & Gr.1 VRC Turnbull Stakes

**Comment** - Should get track to suit and loves the distance. To be ridden from barrier 8 by Hugh Bowman (57kgs)

SAVARIA Aim- To become the first horse since **Domino** in 1990 to land the **Gr.1 NZ** 

Oaks (2400m)/ Australian Oaks (2400m) double

Best win- Gr.1 New Zealand Oaks

**Comment**: Classy NZ raider who is a proven Gr.1 horse at the distance

To be ridden from barrier 10 by James McDonald (56kgs)

**DIADEME** Aim- To strike two Gr.1 wins on end in the Gr.1 Queen of the Turf (1600m)

Best wins- Gr.1 New Zealand Breeders' Stakes (1600m)

**Comment**: Record breaking Gr.1 winner at distance at last start.

To be ridden from barrier 15 by Ryan Moore (57kgs)



WS realised a superb **Gr.1** result in last **Saturday's New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders' Stake**s, with only a neck separating home-breds **Diademe** and **Sports Illustrated** in the Te Aroha feature.

A \$50,000 yearling purchase for Scott Richardson at Karaka in 2010, **Diademe** broke through for her first top-flight success in the event in record-breaking style and represented her sire's **4th Gr.1** winner this season and **8th Gr.1** winner overall.

Crossing the line in a record 1600m time of 1.33.46, **Diademe** also served as the **30th** individual **Gr.1** winner bred by Waikato Stud.

**Diademe** had previously been a dual Group One placegetter.

"It's well deserved for her, a lot of very good mares end up going to stud without a Group One, and Scott has been a great supporter of the stable," said Andrew Forsman, who with senior partner Murray Baker celebrated a stable quinella. "She had been flying in trackwork, but I thought the track may have been a touch firm as she's been feeling her joints. It speaks volumes for her and just how tough she is."

**Diademe** was posted out three wide early before rider Jonathan Riddell allowed the six-year-old to stride up outside the leader. He kicked clear soon af-



ter straightening and she had enough in reserve to hold Sports Illustrated out by a narrow margin. "I had to do a little work, but she was travelling a treat around the bend," Riddell said.

**Sports Illustrated's** effort was full of merit as she had an interrupted preparation after being galloped on two starts back. Rider Craig Grylls reported the **Fast 'N' Famous** mare would improve with the outing.

Both mares boarded the plane for Sydney this week and will pin ears back against each other again this Saturday in the **Gr.1 Queen of the Turf Stakes** at Royal Randwick.



#### **GOLDEN GR. 1 CROSS**

Prior to last weekend, Diademe had proven throughout her career to be very talented, consistent and tough. Her record to that point was 6 wins and 8 placings from 24 starts. She had accu-

mulated one Gr. 2 win, two Gr. 3 wins, and had also been twice placed at Gr. 1 level. So, it was thoroughly deserved when she won the Gr. 1 NZ Thoroughbred Breeders' Stakes at Te Aroha on Saturday in a track record time of 1.33.46 for the 1600m trip. The talented daughter of **Savabeel** will now take her place in the Gr. 1 Queen Of The Turf Stakes at Randwick on Saturday, as she continues the wonderful journey she has given her proud owner, Scott Richardson.

As has been mentioned here before. Diademe is bred on the amazingly successful cross of Savabeel over an O'Reilly mare. The statistics for this cross continue to be extremely impressive. There have so far been just 24 runners bred on this cross, with 7 of these being stakes winners - representing an almost unheard of 29.2% SW/Rnrs. Perhaps even more impressive than that is that there have already been **three Gr. 1** winners from these 24 runners. Any of us would be delighted if we could get a horse to the races and believe we then had a 1 in 8 chance of it winning a Group 1 race!

Apart from Diademe, the other Group 1 winners bred on this cross have been Costume and Savaria. Savaria will also be lining up at Randwick this Saturday as she attempts to complete the NZ Oaks - Australian **Oaks** double for excited owners Des and Kay Fleming. We will certainly be cheering on both Savaria and Diademe, as well as all the other progeny of Waikato Stud stallions who are competing on this wonderful day of racing as part of The Championships.
