Weekend Waikato





Two-time Champion Hong Kong sire **Pins** will look to sons **Ambitious Dragon** and **Aerovelocity** to assert his case at the **Longines Hong Kong International Races** [HKIR] this Sunday.

Billed as the Turf World Championships, the sire has **Ambitious Dragon** seeking repeat glory in the **HK\$23,000,000 Gr.1 The Longines Hong Kong Mile (1600m)** and exciting up-and-comer **Aerovelocity** taking aim at the **HK \$18,500,000 Gr.1 The Longines Hong Kong Sprint (1200m)**.

For Ambitious Dragon's owners Johnson Lam Pui Hung & Anderson Lam Hin Yue, the build up to the

renowned Gr.1 mile feature could understandably have evoked a certain sense of déjà vu this week.

On the eve of his **2012 Gr.1 Longines Hong Kong Mile** triumph, concern ran high that a last minute injury would deny superstar galloper a start.

Fortunately it proved only to be a scare and within hours of being cleared to start by Vets, he was swooping past a field of international rivals to become the toast of Hong Kong.

Fast forward, two years and things are once again

not quite following script.

On Tuesday morning the 8-time Gr.1 winner was treated for a possible foot infection. Encouragingly, however, owing to the immediate improvement made, trainer Tony Millard has remained upbeat this week of the eight-year-old making Sunday's race.

Ambitious Dragon will notably have the services of the internationally renowned Gr.1 jockey Ryan Moore aboard and will jump from barrier 9 - effectively two gates inside what was his successful 2012 alley.

The Paul O'Sullivan-trained **Aerovelocity** on the hand, has drawn barrier 7 in the sprint feature, with champion jockey Zac Purton continuing his association with the talented **HK-2 Premier Bowl Hcp** [1200m] winner.



"I'm happy with that gate," O'Sullivan said.

"He should be able to get a nice run from there. I'd rather have drawn seven than one – Buffering will go forward and he's a good one to follow."
















NZ RACING ANNUAL 2014


The 2014 New Zealand Racing Annual is a landscape coffee-table book, reviewing the 2013-14 racing season through a series of high quality glossy photos.

Pedigree Pointers with GARETH DOWNEY



CROSS OF THE TITANS

As we now head towards the NZB Karaka Yearling Sales Series, it's again an interesting time to review the results to date for stallions, to remind ourselves what have been the strongest patterns in the pedigrees of their stakes winners.

O'Reilly is the stallion with the largest representation in the 2015 Premier Sale, so I have started by taking an updated review of his results to date. One of the strongest proven patterns to stand out

for him is his success when combined with mares carrying Sir Tris-



tram in their pedigree. Of the 77 stakes winners now sired by O'Reilly, 23 of them have come from mares carrying Sir Tristram in their first 3 generations. These have come at a very high rate of 10.4% SW/Rnrs, and have included such star performers as Silent Achiever, The Jewel, Shamexpress and O'Marilyn.



When we find successful pedigree patterns such as these, we can use the search functions provided by the NZB online catalogue to enable us to identify yearlings who carry these patterns. In the **2015** Sales Series, the following yearlings are all by O'Reilly and out of mares carrying Sir Tristram in their first 3 generations:

For those people who like to see a supporting pedigree pattern that helps explain such results, I guess the reality in this case may be as simple as **O'Reilly** and **Sir Tristram** are 2 of the 3 greatest producers of stakes winners to ever stand in New Zealand, and so combining them together in a pedigree is perhaps reason enough for the success. However, there is also a strong theoretical pedigree pattern, with highlights including sex-balanced duplications of the powerful stallions **Round Table** and **Princequillo**, along with duplications of a number of the most influential female ancestors of the breed – including **Knight's Daughter**, **Selene**, **Alcibiades**, **Nogara**, **Mumtaz Begum** and **Mumtaz Mahal**. Whether this theoretical appeal does or doesn't have anything to do with the results, the results are very good indeed and these yearlings at Karaka provide you with a chance to tap into that success.
