

Pins filly MARITIMO to put best foot forward in Gr.1 NZ 1000 Guineas

Quality filly Maritimo highlighted her sire Pins' chance of a second winner in Saturday's Gr.1 New Zealand 1000 Guineas with a commanding win at Riccarton last weekend.

Pins is already the sire of the race's 2009 winner Katie Lee (pictured right) a history-making filly who became the first filly ever to land the NZ 2000/1000 Guineas double.

On Saturday, **Pins** is armed for repeat success with NZ TAB's third leading fancy, **Maritimo**.

Maritimo has won 3 of her 6 career starts, with early black-type honours achieved in last season's **Listed Wellesley Stakes** for training duo Debbie & Graeme Rogerson.



If successful, not only would Maritimo represent her sire's second winner, but the second WS-bred winner in the event behind Daffodil also.

Maritimo (seen here as a yearling) was purchased by Graeme Rogerson for \$200,000 at the Karaka Premier Sale last year

She is out of the O'Reilly mare Miracle Miss, who won five races and finished fourth in the 1000 Guin-



Miracle Miss was covered by Pins in 2015 and has a Savabeel colt heading to the 2016 Karaka Yearling Sales.

O'REILLY - SHEMIYRA COLT

With his full brother **Top Act** claiming Hong Kong's **Gr.3 Sa Sa Ladies' Purse** at Sha Tin last weekend, this smart **O'Reilly** colt ex **Shemiyra (In The Wings)** has been the talk of the stud this week.

Bred by Richard Rutherford along with John and Jackie Cameron, this colt is a grandson of the noted French **Gr.1** winner **Shemaka**, whose **8** winners to race, resulted in **6** winners - half of which, stakes winners.

Shemiyra is booked to Sacred Falls in 2015.





SAVABEEL-SPORTS ILLUSTRATED

Waikato Stud's **Gr.2 Cal Isuzu Stakes** winning racemare **Sports Illustrated** (Fast n Famous) was covered by **Savabeel** on Monday.

Under the guidance of Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman, **Sports Illustrated** has registered 4 wins from 1100–1600m and chased home fellow WS-bred galloper **Diademe** for second in last season's **Gr.1 NZ Breeders' Stakes**.

Sports Illustrated is from the family of champion galloper **Starcraft**.





OCEAN PARK - JUSTA TAD

Fittingly this week's positive pregnancy test is Rudy & Megan Liefting's 2004 **Gr.1 NZ 1000 Guineas** winner **Justa Tad.**

Justa Tad also won the Gr.1 NZ Oaks and was the Champion Filly & 3YO Miler in NZ in 2004/05.

She has produced 4 winners from 5 to race, the best of which being the Listed Ryder Stakes winner Move Faster.

Justa Tad is in-foal to Ocean Park.

BARBARIC

Pins x Burnzees Magic by Kinjite

Top quality sprinter **Barbaric** demonstrated once again just what a lethal prospect he can be when in a fresh state as he returned to winning form in track record time at **Listed** level in the **Legacy Lodge Sprint** (1200m) at Te Rapa last Saturday.

The slick 1:08.53 time smashed Wealth Princess' track record, suggesting conditions were perfect for **Barbaric**.

"With the speed on, it suited him perfectly and it was a beautiful ride by Lee Magorrian as he showed plenty of patience and great judgement to guide him through the field rather than coming wide around them." said trainer Stephen Marsh.

The dashing 7YO was scoring for the 8th time in just a 24 start career to date with five of those wins coming when resuming after a 90 day break or more.

Barbaric is nominated for January's **Gr.1 Telegraph** and is likely to shoot for a second win in the **Listed Levin Stakes** before that.

Marsh was also delighted for the gelding's owners, Rex and William Fell of Goodwood Stud (see 60 Seconds segment profile below).

"It was a thrill to get the win for the Fell's as Rex hasn't been in the best of health of late so hopefully that will be a tonic for him" he said.

Bred by Goodwood Stud, **Barbaric** is one of **66** stakes winners for sire **Pins**. His dam **Burnzee's Magic** won **6** races herself from 1200–1600m and has had the **2** winners from **3** to race.

Burnzees Magic has an Ocean Park colt at foot.

O'REILLY / SADLER'S WELLS - A TOP ACT INDEED

Top Act has been building a high class profile throughout his career in Hong Kong, as indicated by his career record of 6 wins and 8 placings from 19 starts. He has given all indications of being a horse on his way to achieving black type, and he did exactly that on the weekend when he won the Gr.3 Sa Sa Ladies' Purse at Sha Tin. He

burst to the front at the top of the straight with a quick turn of foot and then showed great determination to hold off all challengers to the line.

Top Act is another example of the successful pedigree pattern of O'Reilly over a Sadler's Wells line mare. There have been 26 runners by O'Reilly out of mares by Sadler's Wells-line stallions – these have produced 21 winners (81% winners/runners) and 4 stakes winners (15.4% SW/Rnrs). These are obviously excellent results. Apart from Top Act, the other stakes winners to date are Villifye, Annie Higgins and Spellbinder.

With Redoute's Choice and Sadler's Wells also combining together successfully in the pedigrees of horses such as Miss Finland, Happy Galaxy, Petrol Power, Alzora, Sheer Talent, Castlethorpe etc, this makes Sacred Falls an excellent option to send your Sadler's Wells-line mare to this year.
