WAR AFFAIR Singapore Gold Cup



O'Reilly superstar **War Affair** will bid to become the first horse in Singapore racing history to land all three legs of the Triple Crown in a calendar year this weekend.

The Alwin Tan-trained 4YO has already won the first two legs last month, the **Gr. 1 Kranji Mile (1600m)** and **Gr. 1 Raffles Cup (1800m)**, but will have his nettle well and truly put to the test in Sunday's **Gr.1 Singapore Gold Cup (2200m)**, jumping from barrier 14 with a topweight of 58 kgs on his back.

A high class galloper, **War Affair** has already distinguished himself as perfect three from three winner of the **More Magic 3YO Championship series** and following his track record last start win, regular pilot Danny Beasley has rated him as the best horse he's ridden in his seven year Singapore stint.



O'Reilly has sired the two Gr.1 New Zealand 1000 Guineas winners in The Jewel and Final Destination.

Final Destination's time of **1.34.16** is the fastest Gr.1 New Zealand Guineas time over the last two decades.

In this very race, an **O'Reilly** mare named **Spring** finished 6th at what was her 3rd career start.

Spring subsequently produced a **No Excuse Needed** foal named **Daffodil**, who became the race's second fastest winner over the last two decades in a time of **1:34.39**.





BONANZA CROSS FOR OCEAN PARK

If you own a broodmare by **High Chaparral** and you haven't yet committed yourself for the current breeding season, it has been a very significant week to help direct you in the right direction of
