According to the NZ TAB:

SILENT ACHIEVER is the \$3.00 favourite for the Gr.1 Underwood Stakes [1800m]

SACRED FALLS is the \$4.80 equal favourite for the Gr.1 George Main Stakes [1600m];&

I DO is the \$3.40 for the Gr.1 Windsor Park Plate [1600m]

As if this wasn't enough, there's also the resumption of **Gr.1** gallopers **O'Marilyn** and **War Affair** on Saturday and Sunday.





### Pedigree Pointers with... GARETH DOWNEY



### THE GIFTS THAT KEEP ON GIVING

This last week of racing has perfectly highlighted a number of tried and true pedigree patterns. It is always good to see these patterns constantly reinforcing themselves, and interesting to note that in just one week of racing, we can see so much evidence of successful crosses shining through.

**O'Reilly** – When combined anywhere in a pedigree with Sir Tristram has produced **10.5% SW/Rnrs** and a **Gr. 1** winner for every **46** runners. Examples have included **Silent Achiever, Shamexpress, The Jewel** and **O'Marilyn**. This week's example was **Merion** when scoring a courageous win in the **Listed Living Legends Stakes** at Flemington

**Savabeel** – When mated with **Pins** mares has produced **21.4 % SW/Rnrs** and **86% Wnrs/Rnrs**. The best example so far has been the **Gr. 1** winner **Brambles** who climbed his way above adversity to get back to the winners' circle at Flemington on Saturday with a very tough win

Ocean Park – When Thorn Park has been combined together anywhere in a pedigree with Blushing Groom, the results are running at 10.0% SW/Rnrs and have included the dual Gr. 1 winning Norzita. This week's example was Thorn Prince running 2nd in the Gr. 3 Merial Metric Mile.

**Pins** – When mated with **O'Reilly** mares has produced **8.3% SW/Rnrs**. This week's example was the exciting debut win by the 2yo filly **Maritimo** 

Rock N Pop – When Fastnet Rock has been combined anywhere with Storm Cat, the results have been 20.0% SW/Rnrs and have included the Gr. 1 winners Foxwedge and Irish Lights. Royal Ocean became the latest stakes winner bred on this pattern when winning the Listed Morphettville Guineas

**No Excuse Needed** – When mated with **O'Reilly** mares has produced **10.6% SW/Rnrs**. From just 47 runners there have been the 2 Gr. 1 winners **Daffodil** and **I Do**. This week's example of the cross was **Room For Excuse** winning in Singapore, to now take his record to 2 wins and 6 placings from 10 starts, including a 3rd in the **Singapore-Gr. 2 3yo Classic** 

Rios – When Hussonet has been mated with mares who are either by Danehill himself or are by a son of Danehill, the results have been 11.0% SW/Rnrs and a Gr. 1 winner for every 48 runners; being Reaan, Eagle Falls and Gold Trail. This week's winner bred on this pattern was Magical Sunset who scored his 4th win in Singapore

Successful pedigree patterns like these have been proven over time with numerous results just like last week's.
