#### NZ THOROUGHBRED RACING ANNUAL 2015




# Pedigree Pointers with Gareth Downey



#### **NEVER SILLY TO FOLLOW A PROVEN PATTERN**

As we are getting closer to the "silly season" time of year, Soriano provided another reminder of the outstanding success that Savabeel has enjoyed when mated with mares carrying Silly Season in their pedigree. Soriano has continued to be a super race mare – with her win in the Gr.2 Tauranga Stakes being her 8th win, which now include 2 at Gr.1 level, 2 at Gr.2, 1 at Gr.3 and 1 at Listed. As a 6yo mare, and typical of the Savabeel progeny, she now continues to race as well as ever.

**Soriano** is out of a mare named **Call Me Lily**. Perhaps the most interesting thing about her pedigree is that she carries a **4x4** duplication of the stallion **Silly Season** in her pedigree. This links in with the pattern that has had remarkable success, which is that of sending mares carrying **Silly Season** to **Savabeel**. There have now been **44** runners that combine **Savabeel** and **Silly Season** together on opposite sides of the pedigree, and these have produced **9** stakes winners so far – this representing a su-



perb 20.5% SW/Rnrs. These have also included 3 individual Gr.1 winners, so a Gr.1 winner for every 14.7 runners. Apart from Soriano, the other Gr.1 winners have been Brambles and Pasadena Girl.

There are at least 3 interesting pedigree patterns created by combining Savabeel and Silly Season:

- Silly Season is by Tom Fool, while Success Express carries a daughter of Tom Fool so this creates a sex-balanced duplication of the very powerful and influential stallion Tom Fool
- Tom Fool is by Menow, who is out of the wonderful mare Alcibiades. Savabeel himself descends "tail-male" (along his direct sire line) from the extremely influential sire Sir Ivor. Sir Ivor descends from the same female family as Menow, as they both descend from Alcibiades
- Menow is by Pharamond II, who is out of one of the greatest female influences of the thoroughbred breed; being Selene. Sir Tristram himself also descends directly from Selene, so this is another case of reinforcing a very powerful female ancestor

These 2 key pedigree patterns of sex-balanced duplication of a strong male ancestor, as well as the reinforcement of female families via different branches, are probably the 2 main foundations of pedigree theory that have been followed by theory advocates over the years. In reality, some of these patterns are supported by successful results in practice and some aren't. To have a pattern like this that has a strong theoretical foundation and, more importantly, such very strong results in practice – this gives strong confidence that it is a pattern well worth following; both when planning your matings or when considering pedigree factors as part of your yearling selection process.

Some of the more successful sources of Silly Season in our part of the world include Adios, Al Akbar, Bel Esprit, Blazing Sword, Bold Invader, Canny Lad, Choisir, Hinchinbrook, Integra, Just A Dancer, Lunchtime, Picnicker, Pins, Pre Catelan, Redoute's Choice, Snippets and Snitzel. It looks like it would pay to keep an eye out for an opportunity to combine Savabeel with any of these sources of Silly Season.



In the weeks leading up to and including the Christmas/ New Year period, the Breeding Phone (021 433 251) will be the best mobile number to use to make arrangements with the stud.
