VICTORY MAGIC AIMING TO TURN TABLES




Savabeel 4YO Victory Magic will be aiming to turn the tables on fellow NZ-bred Werther when the pair meet in the HK-1 Standard Chartered Champions ϑ Chater Cup (2400m) at Sha Tin this Sunday.

The John Moore-trained pair staged a tremendous battle in the Hong Kong Derby, going eye for eye, shoulder to shoulder down the straight, before victory found its way to Werther by a head.



Victory Magic subsequently came out at his next start and blitzed rivals over 2200m by 2 3/4 lengths.

Bred by WS, Victory Magic is out of the unraced mare Zephyr Song (pictured left with 2015 Pins filly). Out of the Gr.1 winner Zepherin, Zephyr Song has left four winners from five to race including the stakes winner Whistling Dixie (Pins).







MACKINTOSH GETS THE LOLLIES



WS graduate Mackintosh boosted his Group One prospects with an all-theway win in last Saturday's Gr.3 Rough Habit Plate at Doomben. The son of Pins was confidently ridden by Blake Shinn to post a decisive victory.

"With this horse we've been taking small steps and hopefully now, with a bit of confidence, he can go on to the Grand Prix and Queensland Derby," trainer Chris Waller said. "Winning gives them confidence whether it's a horse, sportsman or businessman."

Mackintosh was bought out of WS's 2013 National Weanling draft at Karaka for \$11,000 by Byerley Park's James Bridge. He prepared the gelding to win two of his first three starts before his sale and transfer to Waller's stable.

"He was a lovely horse to have around. He could light up and had a certain energy about him. Obviously he has a big ticker, but he also has this fast twitch energy that can be explosive. I think this is a part of what makes him so good," recalled Bridge.

Mackintosh booked his ticket to Queensland when he won at Hawkesbury last month in his debut for Waller. "He's an emerging New Zealand-bred gelding with the right bloodlines," he said. "We'd like to see him win like he did today at his next start in the Grand Prix and if he can then he'll be a legitimate chance in the Derby."

Shinn is also keen to stick with Mackintosh in the Gr 3 Grand Prix Stakes at Doomben on May 28 and the Gr 1 Queensland Derby at Eagle Farm a fortnight later. "He gave me a good ride today and in the end it was pretty painless," Shinn said. "Once he found the front he was able to sustain a high-cruising speed and made the race his own."


With the first crop progeny of both Ocean Park and Rock N Pop now making their way to the breakers, positive feedback is beginning to filter back to the stud.

Since selling to Australian syndicator Champion Thoroughbreds at April's Sydney Easter Yearling Sale, Ocean Park's son ex Donna Cattiva (pictured right) has commenced the breaking-in process at Emeran Park, where the early reports to owners have been extremely favourable.



In fact, so favourable that Champion Thorougbreds' Jason Abrahams remarked he has never recieved such glowing reports like it before.

A SPECIAL CONNECTION

One of the most renowned family relationships at work in the modern thoroughbred breed is that of Nureyev and Sadler's Wells. These two phenomenal sire influences are ¾ brothers – with Nureyev being by Northern Dancer out of Special; and Sadler's Wells being by Northern Dancer out of Fairy Bridge, who is herself a daughter of Special.

When Nureyev and Sadler's Wells are brought together in a pedigree, the results are often exciting – and this was again seen in no uncertain terms by the hugely impressive win of Debt Collector in taking out the Sgp-1 Singapore Guineas. With the way the race unfolded, he had every reason to get beaten and yet managed to overcome that adversity and score his 4th consecutive victory and secure his claim to being the best 3yo in Singapore.



Debt Collector is by Thorn Park (who is by Spinning World, who is in turn by Nureyev) out of an In The Wings (who is by Sadler's Wells) mare. Spinning World



adds another interesting connection to the mix as he is out of a Riverman mare whereas Sadler's Wells is out of a Bold Reason mare. Riverman and Bold Reason are grandson and son respectively of another very powerful female influence in

Lalun.

When Thorn Park and Sadler's Wells have been combined anywhere in a pedigree, the results have to date been 9.8% SW/Rnrs – with the stakes winners being Debt Collector as well as dual Gr.1 winner Suavito, Gr.2 winner Te Akau Coup and Gr.3 winner Soubrettes. Ocean Park is of course by Thorn Park and out of the Zabeel mare Sayyida; and Zabeel is, in turn, out of the Nureyev mare Lady Giselle. Zabeel and Sadler's Wells have also combined together very successfully, with a Gr.1 winner resulting from every 76.5 runners on average. The Gr.1 winners have been Dundeel, Werther, Pierro, Lucia Valentina, Tarzino, Tavago, Laverock, Fenway, Gust Of Wind, Gondokoro and Zabeelionaire.

So, if you have a mare carrying Sadler's Wells, and you would like to capitalise on the proven affinities between Sadler's Wells and both Thorn Park and Zabeel, sending her to Ocean Park provides that perfect opportunity.
