#### SAVABEEL KING OF KARAKA



**Savabeel** was crowned king of the ring after his juveniles took centre stage on the closing day of the **NZB Ready to Run** auction at Karaka. Following on from a **\$320,000** sale on Wednesday, the WS stallion's popularity went to another level yesterday when his sale-topping colt was knocked down for **\$460,000**.

Offered by Jeremy Whale's Diamond Lodge, he is from a successful WS family and was purchased by Sydney trainer Bryce Heys.

"We worked through the catalogue as soon as it came out and he was one we had on the short



list fairly quickly," he said. "He just fits the profile of this sale so well as the horses sourced from it are highly regarded in our market and he is from a sire that is producing the results week after week."

Heys said as soon as he got up close to the colt at Karaka he was sold on him.

"I flew in on Tuesday and managed to inspect him that evening and that confirmed he was our main target as he really is a quality individual."

The colt, who breezed up in an effortless **10.70** seconds, will now head

across to his new home at Heys' Ellerslie Lodge at Warwick Farm.

Out of the unraced O'Reilly mare Bling, the 2YO is a brother to the Gr.2 Cal Isuzu Stakes and Gr 3 Westbury Classic winner Diademe and a half-brother to the Australian stakes performed Pins mare Roop All.

In what was a terrific pinhook, Whale had purchased the **Savabeel** stunner out of Waikato Stud's 2014 Karaka Premier Yearling draft for **\$80,000** (pictured right).

Another **Savabeel** son, also from Diamond Lodge's draft, had earlier ignited the ring when he sold for **\$350,000** to Australian trainer John Morrisey. Out of the **Blues Traveller** mare **Tonic**, he had impressed with a smart **10.45** second breeze-up prior to the auction.

"I've had a lot of success here and all of my good horses have come from New Zealand, " he said. "Once I had seen his



breeze-up, and then inspected him before the sale, I was very keen to be the one who bought him. He's simply a lovely athletic type, who moves beautifully and is a real racy individual."

Group One winners **Rockdale** (TJ Smith Stakes) and WS-bred galloper **Lachlan River** (Queensland Derby) have been past Karaka success stories for Morrisey.

The talented Adelaide-based sprinter has registered five career wins for trainer Phillip Stokes, with the best of these coming in the **Gr.3 Caulfield Guineas Prelude** over 1400m.

Of the 4YO gelding's 10 career starts up to 1400m, he has consistently caught the eye, winning five of these and placings on an additional two occasions.

### Pedigree Pointers with... GARETH DOWNEY



#### **ROCK N' THE GREY POWER**

For those of us seeking successful pedigree patterns to try and replicate when planning matings for our exciting young stallion **Rock N Pop**, there were **2** results in consecutive Group races at Sandown last weekend that shone the light on just such a pattern. **Petrology** won the **Gr.2 Sandown Guineas** and then in the next race, **Fast N Rocking** won the **Gr.3 Kevin Heffernan Stakes**. The interesting thing in these pedigrees is that both of these Group winners are out of mares carrying the **Nasrullah** son, **Grey Sovereign**, in their first 4 generations.



This combination of Fastnet Rock and Grey Sovereign has proved very successful beyond just these 2 Group winners. In fact, from just 85 runners that bring Fastnet Rock and Grey Sovereign together within 5 generations of a pedigree, there have been 14 stakes winners, representing an excellent strike rate of 16.5% SW/Rnrs. Additionally, 11 of these 14 stakes winners have been winners at Group level, including the three Gr. 1 winners First Seal, Albany Reunion and Wanted.

There is some pedigree depth support for why this could be proving to be a successful pattern. Nasrullah has become an incredibly common ancestor in thoroughbred pedigrees these days. However, Fastnet Rock, although carrying 1 strain of Nasrullah, does not carry that within the first 8 generations of his pedigree, so this is quite a remarkable lack of Nasrullah in his own pedigree. He does, however, carry strong presences of Nasrullah's close relatives. He carries 5 strains of Mahmoud, 4 of Fair Trial, and 1 of Royal Charger – who are all prominent fellow descendants of the phenomenal mare Lady Josephine. So, perhaps this could be a reason for Grey Sovereign being a powerful partner to combine with Fastnet Rock.

So, whether you are looking to send a mare to **Rock N Pop**, or whether you are looking at his first crop weanlings next year, it could be well worth looking for mares carrying **Grey Sovereign** in their pedigrees. Irrespective of whether the theoretical pedigree appeal is or isn't the cause of the results, the results speak for themselves.

Some sources of Grey Sovereign include Arch Sculptor, Bandmaster, Best Western, Caro, Cozzene, Fortino, Gold Sovereign, Grand Chaudiere, Grey Portal, Hunters Path, Jeune, Kalaglow, Kalamoun, McGinty, My Swanee, Old Spice, One Pound Sterling, Pag-Asa, Pins, Prince Tenderfoot, Raimondo, Royal Yacht, Snippets, Sovereign Edition, Standaan, Tagula, With Approval, Zeddaan, as well as any time Grey Sovereign appears as the sire of a mare on the dam line.
