
WEEKEND WAIKATO

SACRED FALLS' ELITE PEDIGREE COMPATIBILITY

When **Burbero** (O'Reilly ex Royal Remedy, by Royal Academy) took out the **Gr. 2 Missile Stakes** at Randwick in such impressive fashion last Saturday, it was a case of familiar trends continuing. Scott Richardson enjoyed an excellent season on the racetrack last season and that continued in fine style with **Burbero** notching up his 13th career win. **O'Reilly** again took out the **Centaine Award** for global earnings by NZ-conceived progeny last season, and he simply picked up where he left off with this early season success.



As we look ahead to the career of **O'Reilly's** outstanding son, **Sacred Falls**, it is interesting to try and predict what pedigree lines he is likely to cross well with. With **Sacred Falls** being out of a **Redoute's Choice** mare, one way to approach this question is to look at what broodmare sires both **O'Reilly** and **Redoute's Choice** have crossed successfully with. The following is a list of broodmare sires that BOTH **O'Reilly** and **Redoute's Choice** have crossed with to achieve at least **8% SW/Rnrs**:

Bluebird Centaine Citidancer Grosvenor Octagonal Royal Academy Sir Tristram Snippets Star Way Success Express Zabeel

If you have a mare carrying any of these sires in her pedigree then **Sacred Falls** looks like an excellent option for her this year if you want to tap into the proven pedigree compatibility that has already worked so well to date.
