In the HK-1 Chairmans Sprint Prize, he is represented by the Paul O'Sullivan-trained Aerovelocity.

Aerovelocity is currently rated the second top sprinter in the World on Turf and was Hong Kong's Champion Sprinter of 2014/15.

The HK\$10 million Chairman's Sprint Prize has attraced some of the world's most exciting speedsters, with Aerovelocity's leading danger Chautauqua ranking numo uno on Longines current World Rankings Turf Sprinter category.

Aerovelocity is the first Hong Kong trained horse to win three Gr.1 in three different counties during a season, but will need to call on all of his warrior qualities on Sunday, having had a less than ideal preparation following a bout of colic and having drawn the extreme outside barrier 14.

In stark contrast, Pins' other Gr.1 advocate at the meeting, the Ricky Yiu-trained Packing Pins, has drawn favourably in barrier 1 for his HK\$14 million Champions Mile assault.

Packing Pins is a 6 time winner in Hong Kong and is the relative untapped talent in the field, given that he will be trying the mile for just the second time.

"The low gate is not a bad thing, I'm happy with that. He can find cover from there, which he needs at the mile," said Yiu.

Sound Proposition Becomes Savabeel's 11th Gr.1 Winner

50 Stakes Winners Total History repeated itself for Wexford Stables when Savabeel gelding Sound Proposition came off the ballot to win the Gr.1 Manco Easter Stakes at Ellerslie last Saturday.

The win came 31 years after Eastern Joy, trained by Dave and Paul O'Sullivan and ridden by Lance O'Sullivan, also got a late call-up into the Easter field and came up trumps.

"Eastern Joy got in at 7.20am on race morning – Dad (Dave) reminded me off that this morning," said Lance O'Sullivan, who trains Sound Proposition in partnership with Andrew Scott.

"It was a great win and I'm thrilled for all the staff at home. Andrew and all the team have done a great job with this horse and Darren Weatherley rides him in work every morning.

"We were going into it today thinking he's well out of it in the handicaps, but Mickey [rider Michael Coleman] was a bit bullish about his **chances.** He said he likes Ellerslie and it's good to have Mickey back on again today."

Sound Proposition has started just five times since his Derby performance when 3rd across the line and he showed he was back on the right track when winning a Rating 85 1600 at Ellerslie earlier this month.

All told, he has won four starts at the mile distance for owners C & J Tobin, T & S Tobin, R & I Trayling.

"He came into the race through the back way – he wasn't in any of the big races coming in," said O'Sullivan. "He had to earn his spot in the race."

Settled back by Coleman, Sound Proposition unleashed his winning run wide out and nabbed outsider Trojan Warrior in the last stride to score by a head.

Gustavo

Becomes Savabeel's 11th Stakes Winner this season



Gustavo added to a growing list of stakes winners trainers Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman have had by champion sire Savabeel when taking the Listed Manawatu ITM Anzac Mile at Awapuni on Monday.

It was Gustavo's first black-type success.

"We've won some good races with the Savabeels," said Baker.

"There's been Diademe, Lady Kipling, Saavoya, Pipi Beel , Coldplay and others."

Topping the list of the Savabeel performers in the Baker – Forsman yard is Diademe, whose seven wins included the Gr.1 NZ Thoroughbred Breeders Stakes at Te Aroha. Diademe was raced by Scott Richardson, who also bred and races Gustavo.

ALL IN VOGUE ADDS NAME TO SOUTHERN FILLY OF THE YEAR TITLE



All In Vogue (NZ) (Pins) raced to an 18-to-one upset win in Saturday's \$50,000 New Zealand Bloodstock Warstep Stakes (2000m) at Riccarton, ending the NZB Southern Filly of the Year Series with a four-way tie.

Trained in Palmerston North by Kevin Gray, All In Vogue was stakes-placed in February in the Listed Bob Sharrock Memorial Oaks Prelude in New Plymouth. But a run of disappointing form since then meant she was largely overlooked in the lead-up to Saturday's race. She ran 12th in the NZB Insurance Stakes the previous week.

But on Saturday she turned her form around in emphatic style, strongly running out the 2000-metre distance and overpowering her rivals through the final stages of the race. Her time of 2:02.03 was the second-fastest in the history of the race.

A daughter of the Group One winner Tall Poppy (NZ) (Kaapstad), All In Vogue is raced by Peter and Min McDonald of Stratford.

The McDonald Investment Trust purchased All In Vogue for \$50,000 at the 2014 Premier Sale, where she was offered by her co-breeders Fairdale Stud. She has now recorded two wins and two placings from 12 starts and has earned \$42,125.

All In Vogue picked up 7 Southern Filly of the Year Series points for Saturday's victory, putting her in equal first place alongside Canterbury Belle Stakes winner Windborne (NZ) (Darci Brahma), NZB Airfreight Stakes winner Honor That (NZ) (Darci Brahma) and NZB Insurance Stakes winner No Pushover (NZ) (Pins).

-HIGH HOPES FOR BLUEBLOOD-

Tony Pike has particularly high hopes for the beautifully-bred WS fouryear-old Snowdrop. The Cambridge trainer produced her for a first-up victory at Ellerslie on Saturday and is expecting her to continue on a path to the top.

"She's a very progressive mare. She sweated up a bit in the back parade ring before the race, so this will bring her along nicely and she'll improve for the run," Pike said.

"The biggest barrier for her is tracks. She needs good ground. It would be nice if we could give her another run or two in this campaign before the tracks get too wet, but she'll be a lovely mare next season. Hopefully we can pick up a really nice sprint race with her."

By Pins out of the multiple Group One winner Daffodil, Snowdrop collected the fifth win of her 10-start career in the hands of apprentice Ryan Elliot. "Ryan rode her perfectly, and with his claim taking her weight down to 51.5 kilograms that made her pretty hard to beat," Pike said.

Savabeel's successful season continued last weekend, and he now has 11 individual stakes winners for this season alone, including 3 Gr.1 winners.

He also reached another milestone in his career, as he has now sired 50 individual stakes winners – and he therefore certainly looks destined to become one of the top 3 stakes producers of all time in New Zealand. Of course, that group of 3 will include his sire and grandsire – Zabeel and Sir Tristram.


Sound Proposition became the 11th individual Gr.1 winner for Savabeel when taking out the Gr.1 Easter at Ellerslie on Saturday. In joining the list of Gr.1 winners, he also highlighted a very successful pedigree pattern that has emerged for Savabeel. The dam of Sound Proposition, Ebony Babe, is out of a Vice Regal mare. The results to date when Savabeel and Vice Regal have been combined together in a pedigree have been exceptional, as they are currently producing stakes runners at the rate of 21.4% SW/Rnrs. The other stakes winners bred on this pattern have been Saavoya, Duchess Kate, Pump Up The Volume, Bobo So Cute and Ray's Girl.

Perhaps the most interesting pedigree background commonality shared by Savabeel and Vice Regal is that Vice Regal is out of a Le Filou mare – and Le Filou is the ¾ brother to Zabeel's 5th Dam, Vaneuse. So, if this is indeed a part of the reason causing the pedigree pattern to be successful then we should have seen that the cross of Zabeel over a Vice Regal mare would have also been successful. This was indeed the case – in fact it has been an amazingly successful cross. From just 35 runners bred on this cross, there were 5 individual Gr.1 winners! These were Hades, Greene Street, Jezabeel, Grand Echezeaux and Our Unicorn.

Of course, we never really know what it is in a pedigree that causes there to be an affinity – all we know is that it works! So, if you have a mare carrying Vice Regal in her pedigree, and you are keen to give her the opportunity to tap into these 2 incredibly successful pedigree patterns, then Savabeel must be top of the tree for your choice of stallion this season.
