Pedigree Pointers with... GARETH DOWNEY



I am going to take a slightly different approach today, and will look beyond common pedigree factors to look further afield at "stats and facts" in general.

We keep seeing and hearing about the amazing run that our proven stallions are having lately. That is indeed amazing in one sense, but of course this is really just what top proven stallions do – they keep producing top class horses year after year. We are in an incredibly lucky position to have the proven stallion line-up that we have, and we don't take those results for granted – we delight in watching the progeny of our stallions week after week.

Last weekend alone, the progeny of our stallions picked up earnings of \$1.25 million. Pins was the stallion to shine brightest of all, with his progeny earning over **\$600K** of that total. He is a wonderful example of a top proven stallion – year after year, he keeps producing top class horses. This is evidenced by the fact that he has now produced 63 stakes winners. Even more remarkable than that is his strike rate of success - over his career, he has averaged 7.9% SW/Rnrs; which puts him in the very top echelon of sires across Australasia. In fact, of all stallions standing at stud in Australasia, there are only 4 others who have produced at least 10 stakes winners in our part of the world who can claim a SW/Rnrs strike rate as good as that. So, with Pins achieving results as good as this across his career, he is certainly remarkable value to be standing at NZ\$25,000 + GST.
