

PINS' Karaka Million record to date



The Graeme & Debbie Rogerson-trained **Pins** filly **Maritimo** is rated the one to beat in the upcoming **NZ\$1 million Restricted Listed Karaka Million** at Ellerslie on Sunday the 25th of January.

According to the New Zealand TAB, Maritimo holds sway as the **\$3.50** favorite.

After a debut win, the precocious filly achieved black-type distinction in the **Listed Wellesley Stakes** at start two and is expected to take further improvement from her only start since, when she beat all bar one home in the **Gr.3 Eclipse Stakes** at Ellerslie.

Maritimo was purchased from Waikato Stud's draft at the **2014 Premier Sale** by her trainers for \$200,000.



If successful **Maritimo** will represent the second Waikato Stud-bred winner in the event behind **Vincent Mangano** [No Excuse Needed], who took out the race's inauqural running in 2008 for trainer/owners Peter and Kim McKay.

WONDERFUL RUN FOR SAVABEEL CONTINUES

The wonderful run for **Savabeel** progeny continued over the Christmas / New Year period, with the main highlights from this **10** day period including:

- Soriano won the 2000m Gr. 1 Zabeel Classic at Ellerslie
- Saavoya won the 1600m Gr. 2 Eight Carat Classic at Ellerslie
- Saavoya backed up 6 days later and also won the 2000m Gr. 2 Royal Stakes to take the lead in the coveted NZB Filly Of The Year series
- Surpass ran 2nd in the 2400m Gr. 3 City of Auckland Cup at Ellerslie
- Flame Hero won over 1600m at Sha Tin to take his record in Hong Kong to 6 wins

That is indeed an outstanding **10** day period. It is interesting when any of us refer to the wonderful "run" that **Savabeel** is having – because these "runs" are not really runs at all; they are simply what top class proven stallions do. Once a stallion has had enough progeny race to be tested and show us how powerful or otherwise they are as a stallion, they then just "keep on keeping on". **Savabeel** now has sired **35** stakes winners, including **6** at Gr. 1 level. The fact that he has achieved these stakes winners at the rate of **8.8% SW/Rnrs** puts him in the absolute elite echelon of proven stallions, and this is the record he will continue to produce as his progeny keep coming through to the racetrack.

If we look to Karaka and look at his next crop of yearlings, the most common pedigree approach would be to look at successful crosses to date. What **Savabeel** has shown so far, as is so often the case with top class stallions, is that he tends to cross successfully with pretty much anything. The **4** horses referred to above are an indication of that versatility, with them being out of mares by **Just A Dancer, Prized, Bakharoff** and **Pins. Savabeel's** record to date also shows his versatility very well, with his **35** stakes winners coming from mares by **26** different broodmare sires.

For anyone particularly interested in looking for his most successful crosses to date, there are **2** broodmare sires so far with which he has combined to produce **3** or more stakes winners:

- O'Reilly daughters have produced 6 of the Savabeel stakes winners to date, and this cross is running at an amazing strike rat
- e of **26.1% SW/Rnrs**. The stakes winners bred on this cross are the dual Gr. 1 winner Costume, as well as **Chintz**, **Diademe**, **Iggi Pop**, **Nandowra** and **Kudakulari**
- Pins daughters have produced another 3 of the stakes winners, and at another exceptionally high strike rate of 18.8% SW/Rnrs. The stakes winners are the Gr. 1 winner Brambles, as well as Dowager Queen and Lopov
