# **INTRODUCING BANQUO**

Waikato Stud is excited to be offering the first son of Champion sire Written Tycoon to stand at stud in New Zealand, with Banquo joining the 2021 stallion lineup.

An impressive type, Banquo earned his place on the roster after several quality wins over sprint distances.

He proved he could foot it with the fastest, beating home elite sprinters Exceedance, Tofane and Libertini when finishing close up in an illustrious G1 Newmarket H. where the field had collected 11 Group 1 wins.

Banquo was beaten by only .2 of a length in the superb sprint, the G2 Autumn Stakes, a race won by Group 1 winner Microphone, and previously by speed sires Centaine, Canny Lad and Dash for Cash.

By Written Tycoon, Australia's current Champion sire and brilliant sire of juveniles, and a brother to G1 Oakleigh Plate winner Booker, Banquo's exquisite pedigree ensures he has all the ingredients for stud success. Written Tycoon is developing a strong reputation as an emerging sire of sires, with his Golden Slipper-winning son Capitalist now arguably the most exciting young stallion in the Hunter Valley.

His dam, Noondie (Flying Spur) was herself a winner over 1200m, whilst his grandam Creatix (Umatilla) was a Listed winner and three-quarter sister to Umrum.

Flying Spur has proven himself a successful broodmare sire, with daughter Purespeed leaving Champion sire son Sebring. G1 winners Pierata and Preferment, also from Flying Spur mares, are securing their futures at stud with excellent support in their first seasons.

Banquo was a \$600,000 yearling purchase for Bruce Perry Bloodstock from the 2018 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale and was trained in Victoria by Danny O'Brien.

He will stand for \$4000 + GST for his first season, the same fee Centaine began his career at.

While his win in the Listed VRC Springtime H was exciting, we always thought he was a Group 1 horse so we saw it as a stepping stone but unfortunately he had a couple of niggling issues which in hindsight we believed stopped him from winning at the elite level.

At three, his effort to run a close 2nd to Microphone in Gr2 MRC Autumn S was outstanding as was his 5th in the Gr1 Newmarket when he finished ahead of the likes of Exceedance and Tofane.

At four, he really franked his form when 2nd in the Gr2 Bobbie Lewis when beaten in a blanket finish by Zoutori with Tofane 3rd. That was a highlight but there was always a tinge of disappointment that we never saw the best of him.

#### What doesn't excite me about Banquo joining the Waikato Stud roster!

It's great farm with an incredible history of success and for Mark to take him on shows the belief he has in Banquo. He's certainly not there to make up the numbers so it's pretty special for Banquo and his owners as we know he will get every opportunity. Banquo had 16 starts in his career, with two wins and five placings.

He made his debut in the Listed Redoute's Choice Stakes in May 2019. He broke his maiden in his fourth start before backing up 12 days later to win the 2019 Listed Springtime Stakes at Flemington over 1400m on the final day of the Melbourne Cup Carnival.

In January 2020, he was third behind G1 CF Orr Stakes winner Alabama Express over 1100m before finishing a tight second in the G2 Autumn Stakes behind G1 Sires' Produce Stakes winner Microphone. This race has a strong record for leaving top sires, having been previously won by Centaine, Canny Lad and Dash For Cash. He rounded out the autumn with a strong fifth behind Bivouac and Loving Gaby in an illustrious running of the G1 Newmarket Handicap, one of Australia's greatest sprints. In an event where the field had won a staggering 11 Group 1s between them, Banquo finished only 1.21 from second position, beating home elite sprinters Exceedance, Tofane and Libertini.

Banquo had four runs in the spring of 2020, all in Group company, including a second in the G2 Bobbie Lewis Quality. In his most recent preparation, he has had three races with results including a second place in the Listed All Victorian Sprint, and a fourth in the G3 Aurie's Star Handicap.

# FOLLOWING A PROVEN COLONIAL TRACK

One of only five new stallions to New Zealand rosters this season, Banquo is the only colonial-bred stallion option.

Yet for the past five seasons, colonial-bred stallions have dominated both the New Zealand and Australian Sire Premiership tables across all categories.

With Written Tycoon, I Am Invincible, Not A Single Doubt and Snitzel rounding out the top four in Australia, and Savabeel and Fastnet Rock securing the quinella in New Zealand, it's easy to see why yearling buyers continually gravitate toward colonial-bred sires. In fact, a foreign-bred stallion has not won a premiership in New Zealand since 2010 and in Australia since 2015.

Banquo has a resume that indicates he can replicate the stud success of fast, good looking sprinters, such as his own sire Written Tycoon, plus I Am Invincible, Not A Single Doubt and our very own Centaine.

And just like those four elite sires have proven to the bloodstock world, securing a Group 1 win is not a pre-requisite for stud success.
