
It has been another big week for the team with the first of the 16-day scans completed. All the hard work from the dry and wet mare teams is paying off and we've got great results coming through.

Savabeel 4YO **Atishu** recently started her race career across the ditch and is making light work of it, winning the G3 Bill Ritchie H. last Saturday at only her third start. Her efforts have earnt her a place in the upcoming G1 Epsom H. on 2nd October.

This race was won last year by the Waikato Stud-bred champion Savabeel filly, **Probabeel.** A \$260,000 NZB Karaka Yearling Sale purchase, Atishu is from the family of multiple Group 1-winners **Daffodil** and **Aegon**.


