


## **Grace White - Stud Hand & Marketing Assistant** What does your day-to-day role entail? I help in the yearling yard each day, helping bring the horses in and out and then

usually shoot to the office for an hour or so each day to do some basic marketing work alongside Kick Collective. If it's a nice day I try to take the camera for an outing around the farm.


